Senate Bill 1 Funds Work to Resurface SR- 98/111 in Calexico

EL CENTRO, Calif — Caltrans contractors will begin work the week of Sept. 17 to resurface State Route 98 (SR-98) and State Route 111 (SR-111) in the city of Calexico. The project covers SR-111 from SR-98 to Ross Road and on SR-98 from Rockwood Avenue to Cole Road and will result in long lasting repairs needed to sustain a reliable and safe transportation system for the users who depend on these routes.

Lane closures will take place in three-mile increments starting on southbound SR-111 at Ross Road, Monday 4 a.m. through Friday 5 a.m. each week. At least one lane will remain open in each direction for this phase.

Motorists can expect delays up to 15 minutes and are urged to plan their commutes accordingly. Detour signs and one-way traffic control may be employed during project work.

Travelers in the area are reminded to watch for highway workers and construction equipment and to Be Work Zone Alert. The construction zone will be enforced by the California Highway Patrol.

Security Paving Company, Inc. from Sylmar, Calif. will be the contractor on site. Caltrans announced the project in May however, summer weather delayed work. Construction will be completed in spring.

The work schedule is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials, and/or construction-related issues.
