The following is provided as answers to questions from or corrections to this RFP.

1. What model(s) of Apollo camera systems are currently in use?

Models of Apollo cameras vary based on when they were purchased. Most vehicles were purchased in groups and will all have the same setup configuration. Examples of camera types include: RRC236, RRCT29, RRCTMIRA25-C, RRCTMIRA36-C and RRCTM29-C.

2. During what hours would a contractor have access to the vehicles for installing onboard equipment?

The contractor can access our facility anytime during normal operational hours. Monday through Friday present an issue of limited vehicles due to service obligations. The best time to obtain access to the vehicles is during the weekend with Sunday providing the best opportunity due to limited service hours. Evenings also present an opportunity to access vehicles.
