ADDENDUM NO. 3

The bidders are advised that the Contract Documents, Specifications, and Plans for the above-referenced project are hereby amended per the statements in this Addendum.

1. <Bus Stop Signage and Pole- City of El Centro>

Bidders are hereby notified that the Imperial County Transportation Commission (ICTC) will provide the bus stop signage to be installed on each bus stop signage pole.

The Contractor shall be responsible for furnishing and installing the bus stop poles, including all necessary materials, labor, and equipment required for proper installation. The Contractor shall also be responsible for the installation of the signage provided by ICTC onto the installed poles.

For work within the City of El Centro, bus stop poles shall consist of 2-inch by 2-inch, 12-gauge hot dip galvanized square tubing, with 7/16 diameter holes spaced 1 inch on center on all four sides. Poles shall be a minimum of 10 feet in total length, and installation shall provide minimum vertical clearance of 7 feet from the finished surface to the bottom of the sign. The installation shall include a 12-gauge galvanized two-piece anchor into the footing. Braille bus route medallions are not required as part of this project.

Installation shall be performed in accordance with the City of El Centro Sign Installation Sheet EC-830. See Attachment

All costs associated with the procurement of poles, installation of poles, and installation of signage shall be included in the Contractor's bid.

2. <Bus Stop Signage and Pole- City of Calipatria>

Bidders are hereby notified that the Imperial County Transportation Commission (ICTC) will provide the bus stop signage to be installed on each bus stop signage pole.

The Contractor shall be responsible for furnishing and installing the bus stop poles, including all necessary materials, labor, and equipment required for proper installation. The Contractor shall also be responsible for the installation of the

signage provided by ICTC onto the installed poles. Braille bus route medallions are not required as part of this project.

For work within the City of Calipatria, all pole details and installation shall conform to City of Calipatria standards Sheet No. S-130.

All costs associated with the procurement of poles, installation of poles, and installation of signage shall be included in the Contractor's bid.

3. <Bus Stop Signage and Pole- City of Westmorland>

Bidders are hereby notified that the Imperial County Transportation Commission (ICTC) will provide the bus stop signage to be installed on the bus stop signage pole.

The Contractor shall be responsible for furnishing and installing the bus stop pole, including all necessary materials, labor, and equipment required for proper installation. The Contractor shall also be responsible for the installation of the signage provided by ICTC onto the installed pole.

For work within the City of Westmorland, the bus stop pole shall consist of 2-inch by 2-inch, 12-gauge hot dip galvanized square tubing, with 7/16 diameter holes spaced 1 inch on center on all four sides. The pole shall be a minimum of 10 feet in total length, and installation shall provide minimum vertical clearance of 7 feet from the finished surface to the bottom of the sign. The installation shall include a 12-gauge galvanized two-piece anchor into the footing. Braille bus route medallions are not required as part of this project.

All costs associated with the procurement of poles, installation of poles, and installation of signage shall be included in the Contractor's bid.

4. <Federal Wage Rate Confirmation >

Bidders are hereby notified that the United States Department of Labor Federal Davis-Bacon wage rates previously included in Addendum #2 dated March 20, 2026 remain unchanged and are still applicable.

5. <Bid Due Date Change >

Bidders are hereby notified that the bid due date has been revised. The new bid due date is **April 1, 2026, at 2:00 PM**. All bids must be submitted in accordance with the requirements outlined in the Contract Documents by the revised date and time. Late submissions will not be accepted.

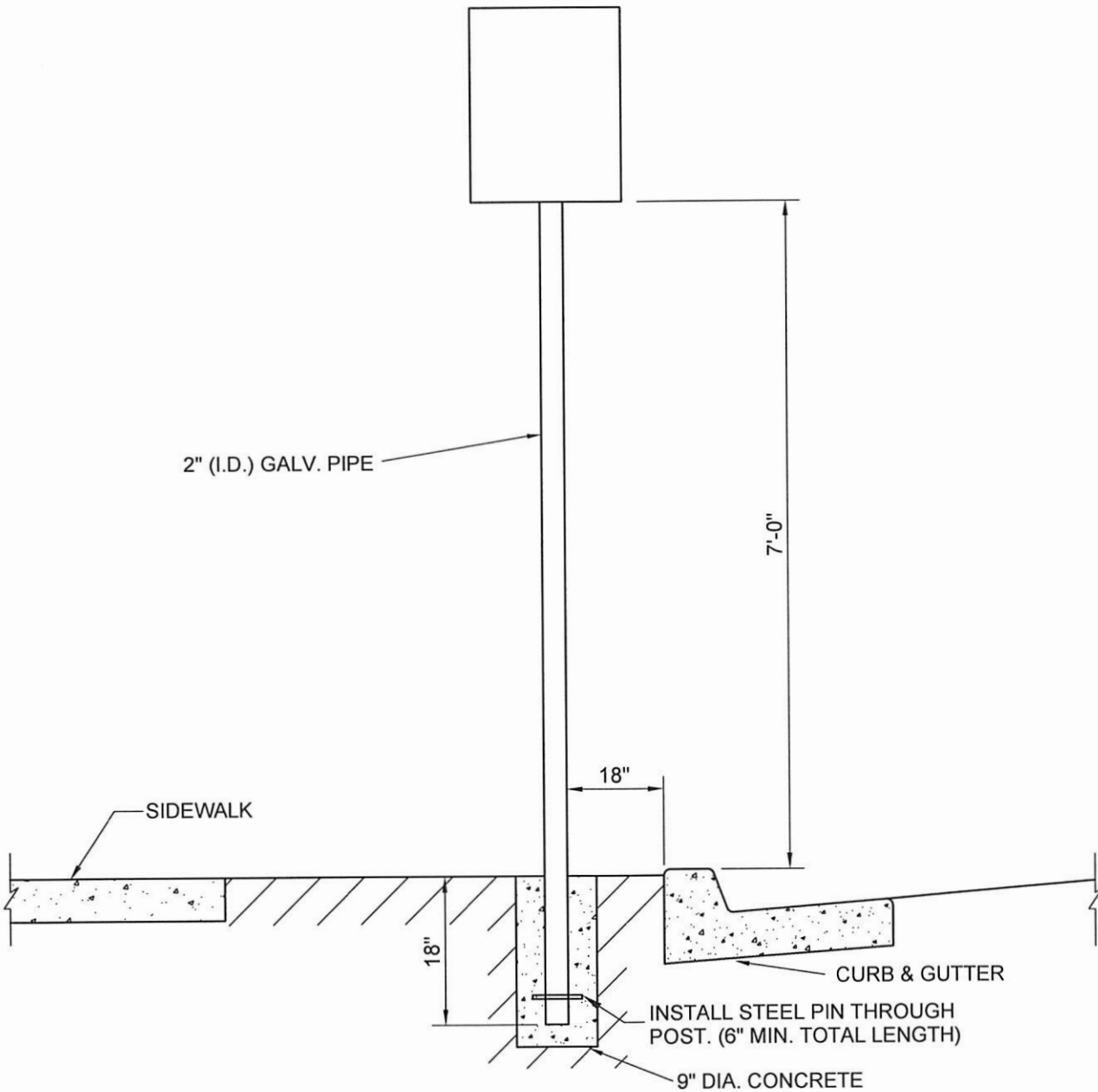
