- 2. Introductions were made.
 - Hybrid meeting.
- 3. Minutes were adopted for February 5, 2025 (Hack, Cordova), Motion Carried.
- 4. Comprehensive Operational Analysis presentation by Jarrett Walker and Associates

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- The presentation was done regarding the Comprehensive Operational Analysis project, which is expected to run through March 2026.
- ICTC Driving Transit Forward will focus on determining optimal transit frequency, service types, and future projections for the next 5-10 years.
- Some of the elements discussed were transit operations, service improvements, and potential new services, along with infrastructure enhancements to help buses move faster.

5. CTSA Reports

Mr. Aguirre had the following information

- ICTC had groundbreaking in Calexico for the Intermodal Transportation Center. Construction starts soon and will take about a year to complete.
- ICTC is progressing with the administrative work needed for the Calexico East Center and designing the environmental aspects for the upcoming Transportation Center. The project is expected to take a couple of years and aims to engage the public for feedback.
- The Bus Stop Improvement Project is nearly complete, with construction expected to start by summer. This project involves procuring and installing shelters at bus stops in El Centro, Calipatria, and Westmorland and a few replacements in Calexico.
- We're currently working on a contactless payment system project, expected to start in a couple of months.
- IVT ride modification is developing the application, aiming to start the transition this July.
 This will involve outreach to cities and their councils, along with presentations about our IVT
 Transition
- The Library Project design is finalized and approved by the City of El Centro. We are now completing the documents and aim to start procurement in the next few months.

Miss Baca presented the following information:

- I visited all the city bus stops in El Centro, Calipatria, Westmorland, Calexico, Brawley, and Holtville, where I placed QR codes. Additionally, I conducted UTN surveys at every city bus stop in El Centro, Calipatria, Westmorland, Holtville, and Calexico, including IVC College.
- Distributed the New Border Express Route flyer at the New East Port of Entry. Also participated in a ride-along on the new express route.
- We will be attending upcoming events and reaching out to all senior living communities for presentations. Jose and I attended a Calexico Mexican Council event and are conducting various outreach efforts.

4. CTSA Reports

Mr. Gomez had the following information

- Comprehensive Analysis (COA): We participated in several marketing events, including the IVC, Navy Air Show, 7th and State, and 3rd and Paulin. We will attend the Children's Fair this upcoming Saturday.
- Our COA survey has been extended to April 6th and includes specific questions for public preference. You are automatically entered to win a \$50 gift card when doing the survey. We have a stakeholder workshop prepared for June. The workshop will last about two

- hours, and consultants will be on site. We will soon provide flyers for our SSTAC members attending.
- We are finalizing the designs for the Bus Stop Improvement Project and hope to start construction procurement soon. We are updating the bus stops in El Centro, Calipatria, and Westmorland.
- We are finalizing a contactless payment system project and are nearly ready to start the procurement process with Caltrans, which is expected to take about a month. The anticipated start date is in August.
- Calexico ICTC construction has begun and is expected to last about a year. We will be reaching out to local business owners to inform them about sidewalk closures.
- We are finalizing a Master Agreement for the Calexico East Port Transfer Terminal this month for commission approval. This will allow us to use TRACP funds to begin the environmental process and secure the location for right-of-way acquisition. The project is expected to take 2 to 3 years to complete.
- Calexico East Port Route numbers are performing well. This route will take you to the bus stop located at the corner of 3rd Street and Paulin Avenue in Calexico.
- The commission approved the property acquisition for the maintenance facility last month. We are now waiting for FTA approval of the final funding. Once approved, we will proceed with the environmental assessments and design.
- The UTN Hearing is next Monday, April 7, 2025.

- Distributed more Border Express flyers and dropped off brochures at doctors' offices.
- Conducted additional UTN surveys throughout Imperial County, including the COA survey. I also attended the transition fair at IVC and the Calexico Wellness fair, and participated in mobility training with the safety manager from Transdev.
- Completed a few ride-alongs, which included Brawley Gold, Border Express Route, and the 2N & 2S.
