a. Transit Planning Updates

- Imperial Valley Transit (IVT) FREE FARES PROGRAM: ICTC received a second grant to keep the Free Fares Program. It is expected to cover until the June/May timeframe.
- Calexico Intermodal Transportation Center (ITC): In the final stages of this project. It is expected to break ground in the June/July timeframe.
- 2022 Long Range Transportation Plan: The public comment period has finished, and it is expected to have the Final draft completed and taken to the board in the December/January timeframe.
- Calexico East Port of Entry Bridge Widening Project: The ribbon cutting took place on November 15th for the first stage of the project. The expected completion date is March 2024.
